With COVID-19 on top of mind for all of us, and respecting our community's safety as our top priority, **from Thursday, November 19th – until at least Monday, December 14th the WRC Thrift Shops located at 3030 US 31-South and 1331 W. South Airport will be closed. This is a complete closure, we will not be accepting donations, or be open for retail sales.** We will continue to reassess the situation and evaluate plans to reopen.

We are going to continue to serve survivors. However, the way we do so will be temporarily changing.

Our emergency shelter will remain open unless additional directives from a unit of government dictate otherwise.

The WRC's main office located at 720 S. Elmwood in Traverse City will be closed to the public.
